Marit Eik has more than 30 years experience and 4 year academic education within Art & Design.

Already before she started her studies in England, she had designed several products for the Norwegian market with great success. Among them were tiles for the one and only ceramic tile factory in Norway.

After her education she became a member of NTKD and her success continued, especially in Japan where several of her designs for textiles were purchased and produced.

Apart from her designs she also made paintings, and in the year 1989 she was invited to participate at a collective exhibition in France. Her artwork was discovered by an art critic, and she was offered a separate sales exhibition at a gallery in Paris. She received great success also with her paintings and all of her 35 paintings were sold within a few days.
